



Dress Code/Electronics Policy

Shoes:

Unsafe footwear such as thongs, clogs, or sandals without back straps, or excessively high heels are not acceptable. Comfortable shoes are acceptable, clean and in good repair.

Jewelry:

Reasonable amount may be worn. Excessive piercings are not acceptable. Boys may not wear earrings, and no body piercings.

School Uniform:

Pants: Khaki, black, brown, or blue colored pants (Twill, Chinos, Dockers, or Cargo) girls may wear capris (mid-calf)

Shirts: Short or long sleeved Polo shirt, button down dress shirts (not Flannel)

Dresses: Girls may wear dresses and skirts that come to their knee, if the hem comes above the knee, leggings must be worn under the skirt/dress.

No separation between shirt and skirt/pants

School sweatshirts, sweaters, good repair sweatshirts and plain fleece pullovers are acceptable over the uniform.

Hair:

Clean and well groomed

Boys: neatly trimmed, off the collar, out of the eyes

Spiked, "Tails", unusual colors, or similar styles are not allowed

Gym:

Sneaker, shorts, sweats, athletic pants, T-shirts or sweatshirts are required for 7th grade-12th grade gym class (sneakers are required for Pre-K to 6th grade)

Dress Down Day

Jeans and T-shirts/sweatshirts are allowed on Dress down days, but must follow the code concerning modesty and inappropriate sayings.

Electronics Policy

Students are not allowed to have cell phones, pagers, PDA's, or other communication devices in school. These should be turned in to school administrator upon arrival.
