Dress Code Policy

We prioritize character over outward appearance. Students must adhere to the standards during school hours or functions. Parents are expected to support these guidelines. When in doubt, choose modest, respectful attire.

General Guidelines:

- **Footwear:** Clean, in good repair, sneaker-type shoes. No flip-flops, clogs, Crocs, backless sandals, or high heels. Work/winter boots must be changed into appropriate indoor shoes.
- **Jewelry:** Boys may not wear earrings. No body piercings other than girls' earrings.
- Uniform:
 - Pants: Khaki, black, brown, or blue (Twill, Chinos, Dockers, or Cargo styles).
 - Shirts: Polo shirts (solid or striped) or button-down dress shirts (including flannel).
 - Outerwear: School sweatshirts, sweaters, or plain fleece pullovers.
 - Preschoolers are exempt but encouraged to follow guidelines. All clothing must be free of holes/frays.

Hair:

- Clean, well-groomed, and out of the eyes.
- Boys' hair must not extend past the collar. No mullets, mohawks, man buns, or unnatural colors.
- Facial hair (if applicable) must be trimmed (½ inch).

Spring/Summer Attire:

- Shorts: Dressy styles (Twill, Chino, or Cargo) with no rips/frays. Must reach at least 1 inch below fingertips. No biker/spandex or jean shorts.
- **Shirts:** Collared shirts are required (no tank tops/crop tops).
- **Dresses/Skirts:** Must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Leggings may be worn for coverage.

Gym Class & Dress-Down Days:

- **Gym Attire:** Athletic pants/shorts, T-shirts, or sweatshirts (clean and in good condition). Sneakers required. Pajama pants are prohibited.
 - Gym clothes must be taken home weekly (washed and returned by Monday).
 - Deodorant may be kept in backpacks/cubbies.
- Dress-Down Days:
 - Jeans, T-shirts, or sweatshirts are permitted (modest, no inappropriate graphics).
 - Hoodies/sweatshirts: Brand logos (e.g., Nike) allowed; no TV/movie references.
 - Sweatpants are not.

Note: Our goal is to uphold a godly standard with minimal conflict. We value the heart over appearance, but believe in maintaining clear, respectful dress expectations.
